

Art & Design

As technologists we will be designing and building our own strong structures to house at dinosaur at a prehistoric theme park.

Computing

As technologists, we will start coding using the new iPads and bee-bots. We will also be using the iPads to support our learning across the curriculum.



As mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of addition and subtraction, and using our number bonds. We will also be investigating place value and recording numbers.

In other areas of maths, we will be investigating fractions; the measurement of weight, volume and capacity as well as beginning to tell the time. If your child owns a watch, please encourage them to wear it so that they can practise.



Science

As scientists, we will be learning about plants and their anatomy. This term we will have a larger focus on flowers.

We will also be learning about the seasonal changes taking place around us.

History

As historians, we will be learning about the geological timescale and how this effected the evolution of dinesaurs. We will also be comparing dinosaurs to the modern animals that have evolved from them.



Music

As musicians, we will be learning about pulse and rhythm.

We will also begin using ocarinas!

Music will be taught by Mrs Hutchings.

Physical Education

As competitors, we will be practising our throwing and catching skills by applying them in a series of different games.

On Tuesdays, we will take part in Yoga classes taught by Penny.

Religious Education

This term we will be learning about the Jewish family and exploring how people from other faiths practise their beliefs.

Important Dates

PE will take place on **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**. Please make sure that full PE kits are in school and jewellery is removed if the children are unable to do so themselves.

Forest school will take place on **Wednesday** afternoon. Children must wear leggings or joggers that can get dirty. Children <u>must</u> have a pair of wellington boots in school for these sessions.

Homework

The children will continue to complete a 'Learning Journal' as part of their homework. They will be asked to demonstrate their learning from English, maths and phonics or topic sessions that week, and may choose their own way of doing so. Please see the homework stuck in books for further details and ideas. Spellings will also be set as part of homework.

Reading is expected to take place every day at home. Please make a record of your child's reading in their red reading journal. As well as listening to their word decoding and fluency, check your child's understanding of what has been read by asking them questions about the text.

Homework will be set on Fridays for completion by the following Thursday. Please support your child with their work as speaking and listening activities will be regularly set, especially in the area of phonics.
