Homework

Please continue to hear your child read as often as you can, and make comments about how they are getting on in their red reading record book. It is important that your child understands and can talk about what they are reading, as well as decoding the words. Please see the homework each week for suggested questions.

Each week the children will be given some spellings to learn at home. They might like to put each word into a sentence, as well as learning how to spell it.

The children will also be asked to complete a 'Learning Journal' as part of their homework in which they will be asked to demonstrate their learning from English, mathematics or topic sessions that week. When it is clear that a child has put a lot of effort into their homework, they may receive an award during our Celebration Assembly.

Spellings and homework will be set on Fridays for completion by the following Thursday, when spellings will also be tested.
