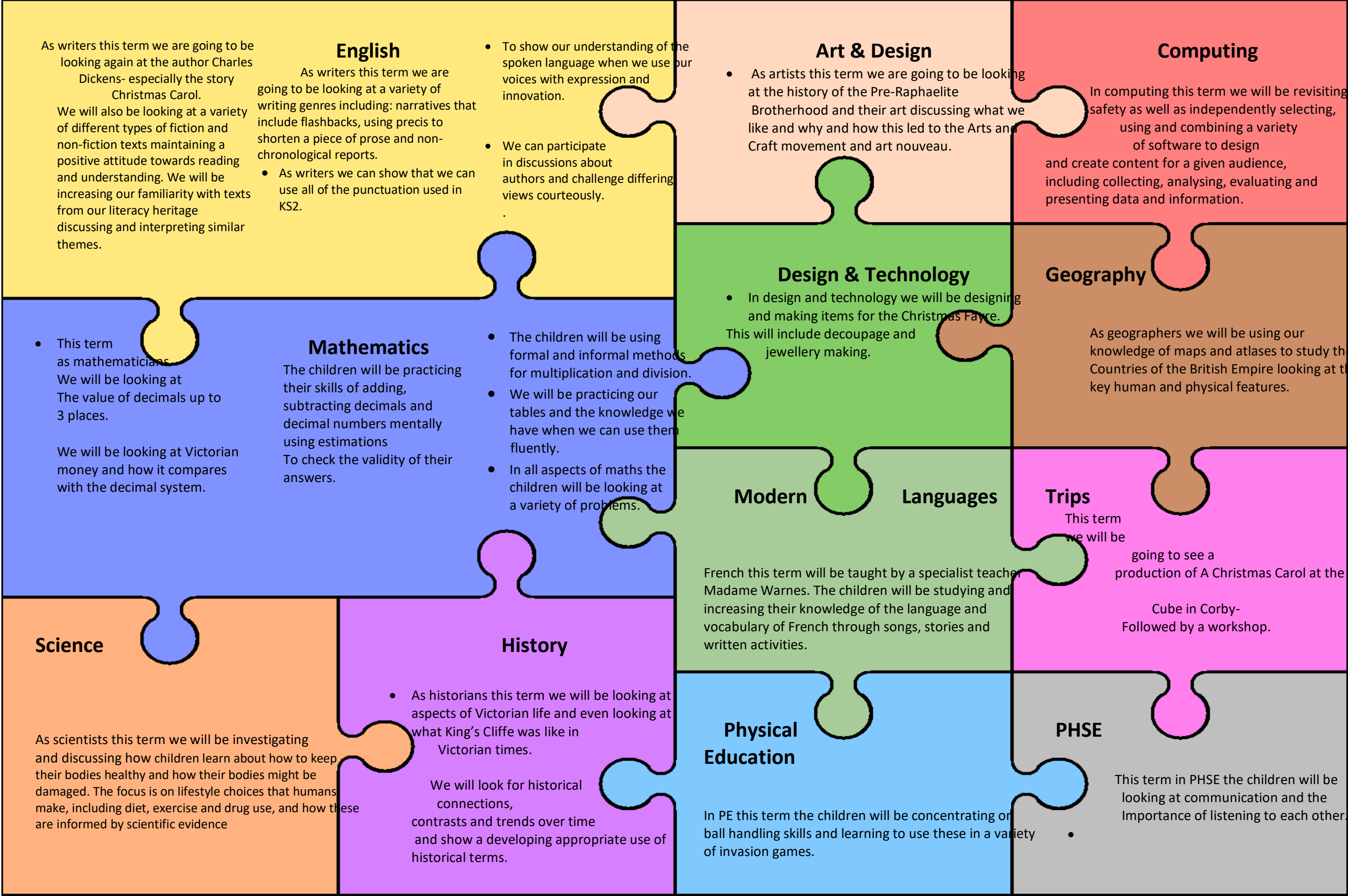


Curriculum Overview for Year 6
