


Curriculum Overview for Year 6

<h2>Maths</h2> <p>In maths this term we will be concentrating on becoming confident in our use of all 4 operations and varying our understanding to be able to solve calculations. We will return to our use of BODMAS and apply this knowledge to calculations.</p> <p>We will also be practicing solving of a wide variety of problems through use of formulae and statistics in a variety of forms. We will be practicing reasoning questions and extending our knowledge of the year 6 curriculum.</p>	<h2>Art and Design</h2> <p>This term the children will be looking at perspective while designing and drawing their own super-hero characters and backgrounds while showing an awareness of scale and proportion.</p>	<h2>PE</h2> <p>In P.E. this term the children will be learning skills of hockey this term.</p>	
<h2>English</h2> <p>As readers this term we are going to be looking at popular fiction, while the children will have the opportunity to read their own choice of fiction in order that they can talk and discuss their views about the author's choice of language and plot. As writers this term we are going to be looking at how to write non-fiction reports using subheadings, bullets points and layout to inform the reader. We will also look at whether to use formal or informal language and where it can be used most appropriately for the reader. As writers we can accurately use active and passive verbs within our writing. As writers we can show that we can use a wide variety of punctuation including: ellipses, hyphens, colons and semi-colons accurately.</p>	<h2>Design Technology</h2> <p>The children will be creating comic flip books to go with their own super-hero.</p>		
<h2>Science</h2> <p>As scientists this term, the children will be learning about the force of electricity, the symbols used and the circuits that can be created. The children will be investigating how circuits can be changed and what happens when they are.</p>	<h2>Modern Foreign Languages</h2> <p>French this term will be taught by a specialist Madame Warnes. The children will be studying and increasing their knowledge of the language and vocabulary of French through songs, stories and written activities.</p>	<h2>History</h2> <p>In history we will be looking at the history of some of the comic characters and the part they have played in popular 20th Century culture.</p>	<h2>Music</h2> <p>Children will be taking part in an exciting new music project at Lyveden, the Elizabethan Lodge.</p>
