It was Remembrance Day on Monday and we held a one minute silence in school at 11am during which the children showed great respect.

Today is, of course, Children in Need day and it is wonderful to see the children and staff joining in by coming to school in their pyjamas and donating to this wonderful charity. We have collected £192.60, which is fantastic. Thank you to everyone for your generosity.

It is Anti-Bullying Week and the school has been holding various activities as part of this. On Monday we had an ALTRU assembly followed by an antibullying workshop for Years 5 and 6. The School Council also did an assembly on Tuesday in which they shared the anti-bullying policy drawn up by the children themselves, a copy of which is attached to this newsletter. Please take some time to sit down with your children and discuss it.

Year 2 took a trip to Stratford Upon Avon to visit the MAD Museum this week. We were very excited because we knew our big DT aim is to make a moving toy based on the Great Fire of London. When we arrived, we were blown away with how many automata toys there were. We think they are really clever because they are mostly made from wood but can move. Most of the toys had a cam system which made the toy move up and down or side to side. Some of our favourites were the 'Serpent and the fish' and the ones where marbles and golf balls traveled around a series of runners and loops. We drew our favourite moving toy so we can continue to be inspired by it back at school. We cannot wait to make our own moving toy in the coming weeks!

The KS1 Sports Hall Skills Competition took place on Wednesday and our KS1 children represented the school brilliantly, coming third overall, which was a wonderful result.





On Thursday, Mr Verrinder, dad to Nell in FS, Tilly in Y4 and Poppy in Y6, came into assembly to talk to the children about his work. Mr Verrinder is a director on the BBC Strictly Take Two show.
