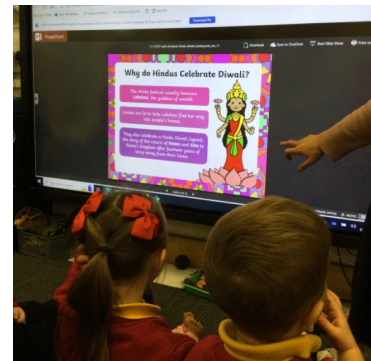

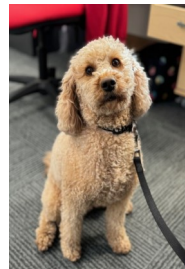

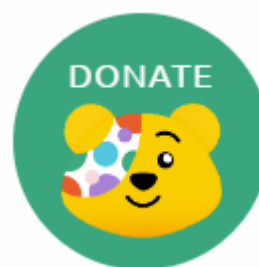
We will be selling Pudsey Badges for £1.00 and Pudsey and Blush ears for £2.50 at playtime from Monday; these items will be **cash only**.
