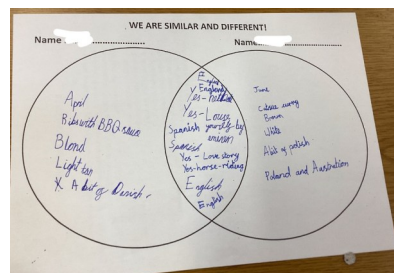
Racism Workshop

On Wednesday our Years 4,5 and 6 took part in a 'No Room For Racism' workshop held by North Northants Council.

Suzanne Preston, Safer Communities Partnerships Officer from North Northamptonshire Council talked to the children about hate crime, discrimination, stereotyping and racism. Suzanne discussed the meanings of each of these key terms with the children, and offered examples of what these behaviours may look like, leading to a discussion around how a victim of these behaviours may feel, why someone may make such comments and what someone may say/ do if they are being racist.

Suzanne then shared an example video from the organisation 'No Room For Racism' where professional footballer Neal Maupay opened up about his experiences of being a victim of racism online, and how he was supported. Neal shared how these comments made him feel and how it affected him on and off the pitch. He described how he spoke up about these comments, sharing these with the premier league and the police and how those eliciting these behaviours were punished as a result.

The children then went on to hold discussion around who the children's trusted adults are and how they could and should react if they were the victim of racism or other hateful or discriminative behaviours. The discussion concluded with a focus on how we as a community and as individuals can challenge people when they behave in a racist, hurtful or discriminative way towards others.

A child can be nominated by a Teacher or peer for a Headteacher/Mabel award. In celebration Assembly the child can chose either a headteachers award or Mabel time.

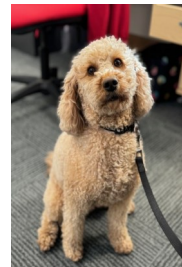
