Reminders

Parents should use Tapestry to communicate with class teachers. Please see your child's class teacher if you need assistance with Tapestry, or if anything is urgent. Please note that Tapestries won't be answered after 6.00pm as we are trying to make sure teachers have a work/life balance.

Please can we remind you that all children should stay with their adult until they are safely in their class room or off school grounds; no child should be allowed to walk from the carpark to their class room unaccompanied unless in Years 5 or 6 with prior consent.

No scooting or riding of bikes on the school grounds.

Children are reminded that trainers are only to be worn on PE days.

The staff and Visitors car park is only to be used by staff, visitors and people who have a parking permit issued by the office.
