Alongside this, Y6 will be use 'Superheroes' as their writing and reading stimuli, linking to our 'real life' heroes. Y6 will be ready for Secondary School with all the challenges it brings.</p>		<p>Y6 Involving their understanding of decisions and how they are made Year 6 will learn through questioning, discussion and debates how Parliament works and how laws are made. Within these lessons, Y6 will develop skills to debate respectfully - being able to discuss controversial topics, and disagree with one another, courteously. During our writing and reading, Y6 will discover and explore superheroes through drama, art and outdoor learning, writing a variety of genres to show a breadth of understanding of both formal and informal writing for purpose. In our transition sessions, we will cover topics to prepare them for Secondary School.</p>					<p>Y6 will develop an understanding of the parliamentary and political system of the United Kingdom; how this compares to other governments around the world and how these have changed over time; they will understand the voting and judicial system, and the importance of their vote. Through the lessons involving drama, art, writing and PSHE, Y6 will become confident in their own views, how to share these, and how to discuss these appropriately in the future.
