Communication

Just a reminder that parents should use Tapestry to communicate with class teachers. Please see your child's class teacher if you need assistance with Tapestry, or if anything is urgent. Please note that Tapestries won't be answered after 6.00pm as we are trying to make sure teachers have a work/life balance. Also if you have an urgent query do not send a tapestry during the day as these won't always be picked up, please contact the school office.

Please can we also remind you that if your child(ren) are off sick, have an appointment or will be on holiday, the school office need notifying as soon as possible. Please note routine dental appointments will not be authorised.

If your child(ren) are taking holiday within term time a leave of absence request form needs completing and either emailed or returned to the office, Term time holidays are unauthorised absences.

Reminders

School doors open at 8.45am to start for the day at 8.55am.

If your child is going to be absent for the day please contact (leave a message) the school office by 8.55am.

If your child has any medial appointments that cannot be made outside school hours, please make the class teacher and the office aware as to when your child will be collected. All non emergency appointments should be made out of school hours when possible and will not be authorised.

If you are requesting any absence we will require you to complete a leave of absence form, these can be collected from the School Office or can be found on the school website.

Due to new EYFS regulations the school will now need to be informed of any Pre-school absences (e.g sickness, holidays, appointments and general days off). This can be done by Tapestry, call to the absence line or via the school office. Any time off will continue to be authorised for Pre-School children.

Please can we remind you that all children should stay with their adult until they are safely in their class room or off school grounds; no child should be allowed to walk from the carpark to their class room unaccompanied unless in Years 5 or 6 with prior consent.

No mobile phones to be used on school grounds.

No scooting or riding of bikes on the school grounds.

Children are reminded that trainers are only to be worn on PE days.

The staff and Visitors car park is only to be used by staff, visitors and people who have a parking permit issued by the office.

Please use The Active Carpark where possible.

Please can you make sure that all school lunches are booked and if you do forget please contact the school office before 10.00am.

A child can be nominated by a Teacher or peer for a Headteacher/Mabel award. In Celebration Assembly the child can choose either a headteachers award or Mabel time.

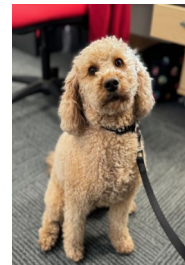
