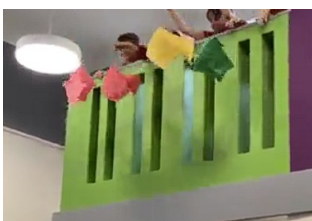
Golf Workshop

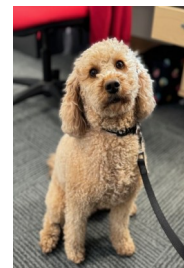
