



Medium Term Plan – Year 3 (Autumn)
STONE AGE

<p><u>Intent:</u></p> <p>In the autumn term the children will explore the historical events and geographical features of Stone age, paying particular attention to the impact this had on Ancient Britain. The children will develop an understanding of how the events of the Stone Age have affected the world, whilst gaining a deeper knowledge of how materials were used and developed to progress society. The children will build on their knowledge of the differences between the present and past. They will begin to understand the use of maps and gain more knowledge about why settlements were built where they were and how this is still relevant today.</p>	<p><u>Implementation:</u></p> <p>Through a range of active and immersive lessons the children are going to learn about the ancient Britain and the tools that were used, followed by geographical knowledge, through outdoor practical lessons, enrichment trips, videos and use of a range of secondary sources. The children will get to enrich their understanding through drama and literacy tasks as well as extra-curricular topic lessons, science and activity days. The children will be immersed in the learning which will include art, maths geography, and PE lessons</p>	<p><u>Impact:</u></p> <p>The children will be able to confidently explain the impact of the Stone Age on Britain. They will begin to understand how society emerged and where settlements gathered. They will learn more about map work and start to have opinions about how clues left behind from the past can be interpreted. They will begin to understand that opinions may vary about our past and understand some of the reasons behind this.</p>	<p><u>Celebration:</u></p> <p>The children will have many opportunities to celebrate their learning throughout the term. These will include sharing POW projects, outside visitors (if possible) and share their learning on Tapestry.</p>
