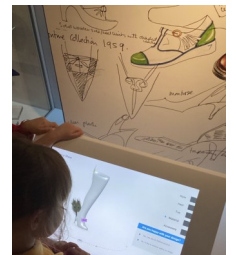
Harvest Festival Service

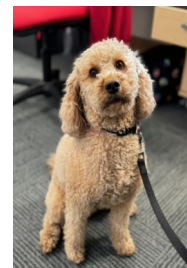
