



Kings Cliffe Eco Council Action Plan 2025-26

Topic 1	Biodiversity
Aim	Create a pond. Raise awareness and knowledge of wildlife.
Action	Plan to make a pond, involving local businesses to contribute. Take part in the Great British Bird watch. Take part in the Great British Butterfly count. Art competition for Bird week- heightening bird identification and awareness of different species. Create bug habitats look at using the log pile and upkeep of current habitats.
Informing and involving	Communicating through Newsletters, Posters, Assemblies, social media, Tapestry and Noticeboards. Include local community and parents asking for volunteers and support. Bird and butterfly hunt and activities during Happy lunch times, i.e. create bird feeders.
Monitoring and Evaluation	Number of entries to the art competition. Look at impact of the pond and classes that have used it.

Topic 2	Waste
Aim	To reduce waste and inform how. Change attitudes towards preloved items. Reduce single use plastics. Educate about recycling. Green lens glasses in every classroom.
Action	Create a swap shop for Halloween, Christmas jumpers. Preloved book stall on world book day-Any books left to be offered to the library and then donated to charity. Battery recycling station. Speak to the kitchen about paper bags not plastic. Reduce laminating using our green lens approach. Take part in cut your carbon. Green lens to be used in classroom when thinking in an eco-conscious way to make awareness an everyday presence and way of thinking. Take part in the big school clean up.
Informing and involving	Eco team to advertise and ask for donations for swap shops. Swap shop to be available in school for donations and selection. Create posters. Tapestry, social media and newsletter to inform parents. Assemblies to inform.
Monitoring and Evaluation	Monitor how many books get taken. Count batteries. Monitor laminate pouches. Count bags of litter collected.

Topic 3	Marine
Aim	To reduce the use of plastic and raise awareness of the impact of plastic in our oceans.
Action	Share knowledge how on to reduce use of single use plastics. Survey the school to find areas of high use, create a plan to help reduce. Take part in plastic free July. Create awareness of things that can be used instead of plastic. Creating a plastic mural using recycled plastic.
Informing and involving	Posters, tapestry, social media, assembly and newsletter. Look at making a video of useful ways to avoid using plastic and using alternatives. Lunch time activities in July to inform and raise awareness.
Monitoring and Evaluation	Monitor the number of plastic items ordered. Survey the use of plastic.
