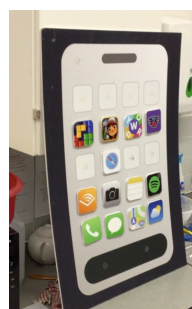
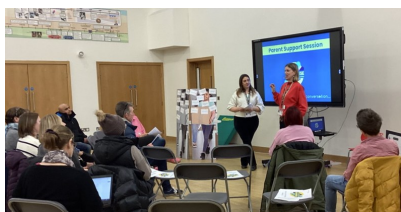
Year 2 'Tou' Can do

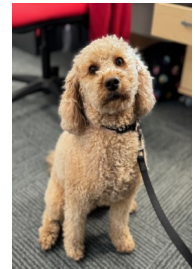

• Google Chrome • Firefox • Safari • Opera

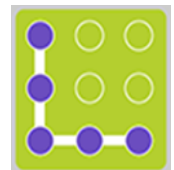
We cannot recommend using Internet Explorer for Letter-join.
