On Monday, our Y3/4 Indoor Athletics Team went to the County finals at Kettering Leisure Village and competed against 14 other teams in their age category! As the smallest school there, by quite a margin, we managed to represent and hold our own amazingly. Our athletes competed in a variety of track and fielding events throughout the morning: obstacle relay, 1:1 relay, 2:2 relay, 1:1 hurdle relay, 6 lap paarlauf, over/under relay, 4:1 relay, chest push, standing long jump, five strides, standing triple jump, vertical jump, soft javelin, and speed bounce! They all ran, bounced, threw, jumped and supported one another in the most wonderful way, representing our school on the field and track but also from the sidelines with heart and love! Well done to all the children who took part; thank you to all the staff who helped with training and supporting and a massive thank you to all the parent/families who helped with transport and for being cheerleaders.

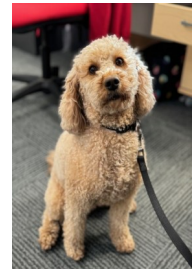
