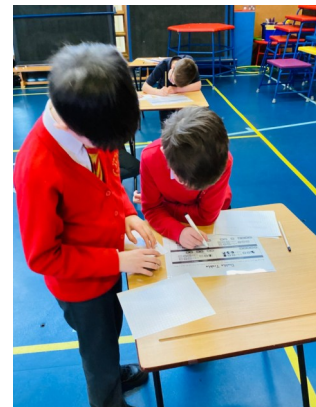
#### Year 1 'Tou' can do

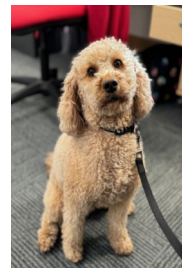
