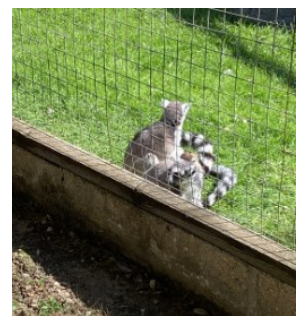
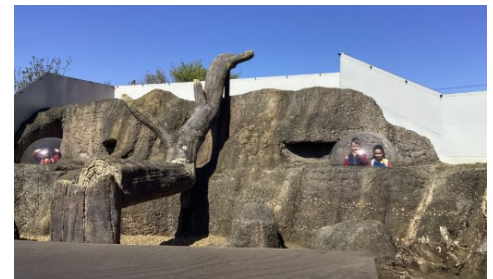

Mabel time.

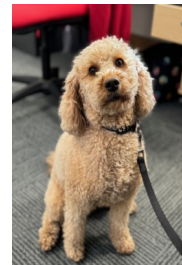
