<p><u>Intent</u> We are teaching this topic in order that the children learn about similarities and differences in transport and holiday destinations. They will also learn about Space and the key events from the past that have taken place including the Wright Brothers first flight. We will look at air craft nowadays and compare to first planes.</p>	<p><u>Implementation</u> Children are going to learn about Sir Frank Whittle an English Air Force Officer. They will consider questions and create a fact file about his life and achievements. They will be studying explanation texts and then write their own to explain how something works. They will discover how holidays have changed and compare-travel, accomodation, beaches and activities over time.</p>							<p><u>Impact</u> We will measure how children understand different ways of travelling including air travel and how holidays have changed. At the end of the topic the children will know the difference between different holiday destinations both in the UK and aboard. Through research they will have gained the understanding of the varying ways to travel such as space rockets and planes and compare changes to these forms of transport over time. They will have designed and made space rockets using tools and equipment making improvements and reflecting on their successes. As geographers they will be able to use maps to name countries and holiday destinations. They will have the ability to research the past using non fiction books and create fact files with this information.</p>							<p><u>Celebration</u> The children will celebrate their understanding of their topic through our Class Assembly. The children's learning will be shared through Tapestry messages home. The children will show their learning through their POW homework projects.</p>
