ECO Council

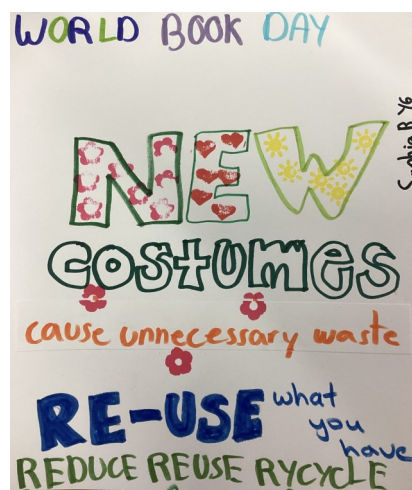
The ECO Council would like you to be Eco Conscious and would encourage you to reuse/recycle/swap and borrow; not only is this cost effective it helps save the Planet!
