These rules help us to keep safe on the Internet:

'Think then Click'

- We only use the internet when a trusted adult is with us.
- We only use websites we know are safe and age appropriate.
- If we are unsure about a website we ask a grown up to check it first.
- When using the internet, if something pops up we are unsure of, we will speak to a trusted adult straight away.
- We only open and send e-mails to friends and family and we make sure a responsible adult is with us.
- We will keep our phones, tablets and any other electronic devices at home and not bring them into school.
